NO.MG.115/2007 /31 In exercise the powers conferred by Sub Section (2) of Section 4 of the Meghalaya Mineral Cess Act.1988 (Act 7 of 1988), the State Government order that the revised rate of Cess on Limestone, Sillimanite and fire Clayrefer to at clauses (b),(c), and (d)of Sub section (1) of Section 4 of the aforesaid Act.shall, with immediate effect be Rs.20/- per metric tones. and Rs.300/-per metric tones and Rs.5/- per metric tones, respectively.

As regards the feasibility of having differential rates Cess for minerals which are meant for export outside the Country, the Status Quo is allowed to prevail for the present.

The Notification No.MG.116/88/87 dated 31.3.1992 is herby superceded.
